Good morning,

Due to many requests for information in reference to a traffic stop initiated by a Summerville Police officer on March 21st, 2021, I would like to provide some details surrounding the stop. On said date, the Summerville Police Department received several 911 calls in reference to gun shots being heard at approximately 10:37 pm. Within minutes of the Summerville Police Department receiving these emergency calls, a Summerville Police officer observed a vehicle possibly being involved in the shooting leaving the area of the reported gun shots. The vehicle was observed to not have headlights on while on the roadway. The officer proceeded to stop the vehicle by traffic stop. Due the seriousness of the vehicle possibly being involved; a felony traffic stop was conducted. Once the officer found the vehicle to not be involved, the driver was released from detention and was issued a written warning for no headlights.
